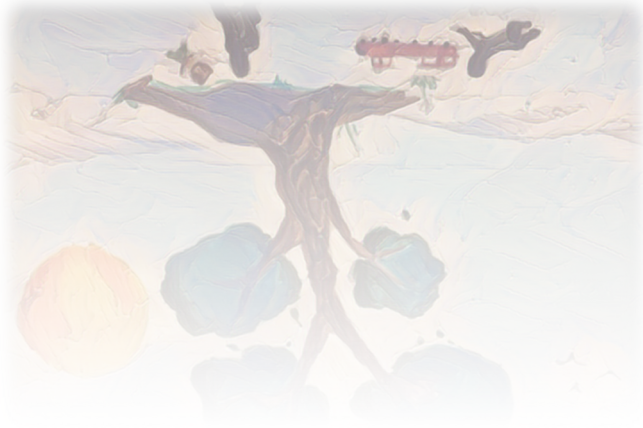




THREE YEARS
